## Collier Chapel and Children's Cemetery Use Agreement

In accordance with the Facility Use Agreement between the Association of Ex Pupils (AXP®) and Athletics in Action (AIA) dated January 19, 2018, and the restriction imposed by the State of Ohio, the following outlines the protocol for Facilities' use.

- 1. <u>Usage</u>. AXP shall have use of the Collier Chapel and the Children Cemetery on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. There will be no cost for the use of the Chapel.
- 2. **Procedure for Usage.** The Operations Department at AIA will be responsible for the scheduled use of the Chapel and internments in the Cemetery.
  - a. Requested Chapel use must be pre-approved in writing through the AXP® Board at least thirty (30) days in advance of the proposed usage. Usage of the Chapel is subject to availability with usage by AIA or any licensee, sublessee, invitee, or guest of AIA having priority over use by the AXP or its ex-pupils. The use of the Chapel under the AXP® request shall not include any religious related activities. AXP shall be solely responsible for all clean up after use of the Chapel and to restore the Facility to its original condition.
  - b. For the Cemetery, effective January 9, 2018, only ex pupils' cremated remains will be allowed burial. Once the available burial space is full, no other provisions will be possible. No full body burials are permitted at the Cemetery. Ex-pupils wishing to be buried or have their ex-pupil family members buried must first receive written approval from the AXP® Board after which the Board will forward the request to the AIA. All the expenses associated with the burial shall be borne by the family of the person whose remains are being buried.
- 3. <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement shall be for an initial term of ten (10) years from January 19, 2018, and renewable thereafter every ten (10) years so long as: (i) AIA has management responsibility for the Facilities; and (ii) AXP remains a non-profit organization under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and in good standing as a non-profit corporation with the Ohio Secretary of State.
- 4. <u>Code of Conduct</u>. AXP's use shall be subject to the Athletes in Action Code of Conduct, Athletes in Action Standards of Occupancy, and Campus Crusade for Christ Statement of Faith, copies of which are available through the AXP Board.
